Itinerary Day of the Dead Altar

Duration:
3 days / 2 nights

Day 1- Morelia, Quiroga

Early in the morning, we start with a tourist bus tour in order to visit the main attractions in comfort. 3 1/2 hours

Next we will visit the Candy Museum to learn the secrets behind making of different quince candy pastes. At the candy market we will be able to taste everything we learned at the museum. 2 hours approximately

A little later on, we will visit Aceite Gourmet Regant factory and learn about the different products made from the avocado. 2 hours approximately

We travel to Quiroga, a 40 minute approximately, where we will tour the Gastronomic Market and taste the famous Quiroga carnitas 1 1/2 hours approximately

Overnight stay in Quiroga

Day 2- Santa Fe de la Laguna

We will start early in the morning by driving to Santa Fe de la Laguna a 40 minute trip approximately, where we will take a class at the Santa Fe de la Laguna workshop. We will prepare different dishes in the traditional manner

We will continue our tour and stop at Tzintzuntzan, only 12 minutes away. Here will visit the archeological zone, the crafts market and a pottery workshop. 4 hours approximately

We will continue our journey to the Magic Town of Pátzcuaro, approximately 20 minutes away. Here we will visit a shop where they make chocolate in the traditional manner. 1 1/2 hours approximately

We will make a quick stop at the Eréndira Ice Cream Parlor in order to try the traditional nieve de pasta. Looks like vanilla ice cream but tastes so much better. We will also taste the traditional chongos Zamoranos a sweet made of curdled milk

Our last activity will be a visit to the Museum of Popular Arts and Crafts. 1 1/2 hours approximately

Overnight stay in Patzcuaro

Day 3- Santa Clara del Cobre, Zirahuén.

For the last day of our interesting tour we will travel to Santa Clara del Cobre. After a short 20-minute stroll we arrive at El Portón copper workshop where we will watch these experts shape the copper sheets into magnificent pieces. It is possible to purchase items here. 1 1/2 hours approximately

We will then go to the Zirahuén Lagoon where we will be able to practice one of the many water sports offered here in this beautiful and calm landscape 3 hours approximately

Day 1- Morelia, Quiroga

We will start our tour by leaving the City of Morelia early in the morning. We will take a tourist bus in order to visit the main sites in comfort. 3 1/2hours

Day 2- Santa Fe de la Laguna

Overnight stay in Patzcuaro

Día 3- Zirahuén.

For the last day of our interesting tour we will travel to Santa Clara del Cobre. After we take a short 20-minute stroll we arrive at El Portón copper workshop where we will watch these experts shape the copper sheets into magnificent pieces. It is possible to purchase items here. 1½ hours approximately

We will then go to the Zirahuén Lagoon where we will be able to practice one of the many water sports offered here in this beautiful and calm landscape 3 hours approximately

The more adventurous will try the most scenic zip-lining in the country 30 minutes approximately

In the afternoon we will take a very typical boat ride on the lagoon and go fishing for charales and the native white fish. 1 hour approximately

Overnight stay in Zirahuén

Day 4- Uruapan

Early in the morning we will leave for Uruapan an approximate trip of 40-minutes

Here we will visit Juan Sepulveda Archeological Museum 1hour approximately

Our next stop is the Charanda Distillery where we will observe the production process of this alcoholic liqueur made from sugar cane. This liqueur has a certificate of origin. 1hour 15 minutes

We will then stop at the ice cream factory Paletas Urani, where we will learn about the techniques used to make these very famous paletas made with the fruits found in the area. 40-minutes approximately

In the afternoon we will visit the Antojito Market (antojitos are typical Mexican street snacks). We will be able to try different foods typical of Uruapan 1 1/2hours approximately

We will drive to the 60-meter cascade La Tzaráracua about 5 kilometers south of Uruapan. 45 minutes approximate

Overnight stay in Uruapan

Day 5 - Uruapan

We will start our day by visiting what is probably the narrowest house in the world. It has a width of 1.42 meters, 10.20 meters in depth and is 4 story's high. 30 minutes approximately

We will then spend the rest of the day at Cupatitzio Canyon where we will do some hiking. We will also catch the Rainbow trout we will eat later. 4 hours approximately
