Day 1- Taxco

We will start our tour in Guerrero's Magic Town of Taxco

The first activity consists of a visit to the Ballesteros silver workshop where we will observe the experts work the silver. There is a jewelry shop where you will be able to choose from a wide variety of beautiful articles. 1 hour approximately

We will then go and see a tortilleria where you will have a hands-on experience making of tortillas. 45 minutes approximately

Later on we will visit the main cultural attractions of the city as well as its historical monuments 1½ hours

At the hotel Posada Misión we will learn the secrets and techniques for preparing flower beverages. 1 ½ hours approximately

Our last activity of the day will be a visit to the Organic Mezcaleria at the same hotel. 45 minutes approximately

Overnight stay in Taxco

Day 2-Cuernavaca,Tepoztlan, Yecapixtla

We will travel to the State of Morelos where approximately 1½hours later we will reach Cuernavaca. We will tour the downtown Historic center and visit Robert Brady Foundation located in the XVIth century meteorological observatory of a Franciscan convent. We will tour the incredible selection of modern art collected by this lowan artist in his lifetime. 2 ½ hours approximately

Afterwards we will travel to the Magic Town of Tepoztlan a drive of about 25 minutes approximately. Here we will take a cooking class at Villa Bonita starting with a visit to the market to choose our ingredients. After lunch we will visit the crafts market and climb the Tepozteco. 3 hours approximately

A short 30-minute drive and we arrive in Yecapixtla where we will polish our bartering techniques in the market. 1 ½ hours approximately

Our last visit of the day will be to a cream and cheese dairy. These products always accompany the famous Yecapixtla cecina (cured meat) 1 ½ hours approximately

Overnight stay in Yecapixtla

Day 3- Teotihuacan

Early in the morning we leave for Teotihuacan in the state of Mexico a 2-hour trip. We will visit the world famous pyramids followed by an obsidian workshop visit in San Martin de las Pirámides. 3 ½ hours approximately

Our next stop will be Otumba, a 15-minute drive, where we will tour Rancho El Pabellon. A variety of workshops are available; you can learn how to make different products with a pulque, maguey, prickly pear base and many other natural raw materials. 1 ½ hours approximately

Next we will visit the Gonzalez Carrasco museum. 1 hour approximately

Our last visit in the State of Mexico will be in Nopaltepec about 16-minutes away where we will have a workshop on grana cochinilla (cochineal). We will learn how they extract the beautiful natural colors from this insect. 1hour approximately

Day 1- Taxco

Overnight stay in Taxco

Day 2-Taxco, Cuernavaca

We will return to Hotel Posada Misión where we will learn the secrets and techniques for preparing flower beverages. 1 ½ hours approximately

We will travel to the State of Morelos where approximately 1½hours later we will reach Cuernavaca. We will tour the downtown Historic center and visit Robert Brady Foundation located in the XVIth century meteorological observatory of a Franciscan convent. We will tour the incredible selection of modern art collected by this lowan artist in his lifetime. 2 ½ hours approximately

In the beautiful gardens of Las Mañanitas we will enjoy a unique gastronomical experience. 2hours approximately

In the afternoon we will visit Jardin Borda and the Traditional Medicine Museum. 2hours approximately

Overnight stay in Cuernavaca

Day 3- Tepoztlan, Yecapixtla

We will travel in the morning to the Magic Town of Tepoztlan a drive 25-minute approximately. Here we will take a cooking class at Villa Bonita starting with a visit to the market to choose our ingredients. After lunch we will visit the crafts market and climb the Tepozteco. 3 hours approximately

A short 30-minute drive and we arrive in Yecapixtla where we will polish our bartering techniques in the market. 1 ½ hours approximately

We will then visit a cream and cheese dairy products that always accompany the famous Yecapixtla cecina (cured meat) 1 ½ hours approximately

Overnight stay in Yecapixtla

Day 4- Teotihuacán

Early in the morning we leave for Teotihuacan in the state of Mexico a 2-hour trip. We will visit the world famous pyramids followed by an obsidian workshop visit in San Martin de las Pirámides. 5 hours approximately
