### Day 1

In the evening we will have a tasting of mescal at the Corazon de Maguey; these will be from different areas of the country. 1 ½ hours approximately

Overnight stay in Mexico City

### Day 2

We start our day visiting the Museum of Anthropology's Mexica exhibition. This will give us an excellent idea of a market in the days of the Aztecs. 1 ½ hours approximately

From there we go to Pujol, listed among the top 50 restaurants of the world, where Chef Enrique Olvera will give us a Mexican modern cooking class using the traditional ingredients we saw at the Museum. 3hours

This will be followed by a spectacle of Mexican wrestling (lucha libre) in Arena Mexico. 1½ hours approximately

Diner will be at Casa Biko where you will have the opportunity to prepare your own dishes. 2hours approximately

Overnight stay in Mexico City

This will be followed by a visit to Coyoacan market. This will allow us to understand the way a market operates. Before we leave we will eat at the famous Tostadas de Coyoacán 1 ½ approximately

For our next activity we will visit the Coyoacan arts and crafts market. 1 hour 15 minutes approximately

Our last stop of the day will be a visit to the Frida Kahlo Museum 1 hour approximately

Overnight stay in Mexico City

**Day 4**

We will start the day with a bus ride on the Turibus to see the principal areas of the city Approximately 4 hours

We will tour the historic downtown and visit some of Mexico City's famous cantinas 2hours approximately

This will be followed by a visit to the Herdez Mexican Gastronomic Library 1 hour approximately

We will end our evening at Plaza Garibaldi where we will enjoy the traditional music and food of Mexico
