Day 1- Coatepec

Our gastronomical tour starts in Jalapa. From here we will travel to Coatepec, an 8-kilometer journey, where our first stop will be the Orchid House. We will take a course in growing, pollination or in vitro growth of orchids. 1 ½ hours approximately

This will be followed by a visit to El Café-Tal museum where we will take a tour through their coffee plantation. We will end the visit with a coffee tasting. 2½ hours approximately

Our next activity will bring us into direct contact with nature. We will visit La Granada Cascades. 2 ½ hours approximately

Our next stop is Hacienda El Trianón where we will see the famous high grown coffee beans Café de Altura. Next is a visit to the regional Bio-Market where we will taste the wide variety of organic products and typical dishes of the area. 2 ½ hours approximately.

At La Aurora we will observe the processing of sugar cane. Approximately 1hour 15-minutes

We will end our day by visiting Los Dos Polos ice-cream Parlor where we will have some coffee ice cream specialty of the house. Approximately 30minutes

Overnight stay in Coatepec

Day 2- Veracruz

In the morning, we will start our 1hour 40-minute drive to the Port of Veracruz where our first stop will be the famous Café La Parroquia. We will enjoy the traditional lechero a mixture of strong coffee and milk. The lechero served in a glass is absolutely delicious. 1hour 15-minutes approximately

Next we will take a tour of the port; visit the historic downtown, the main monuments of the city as well as the Historic Naval Museum of Veracruz 2hours30-minutes

Later a stroll down the sea walk will take us to Nieves Güero Güero ice cream parlor. 40-minutes approximately

In the afternoon we will head for Boca del Río where we will spend the afternoon on the beach. We will be able to take a boat ride and see the local fisherman fishing. 3hours approximately

Day 3- Gutierrez Zamora

In the morning, we will start our 1hour 40-minute drive to the Port of Veracruz where our first stop will be the famous Café La Parroquia. This will be followed by the vanilla tour in the historic downtown area of Papantla 2hours approximately

Will start our journey to Poza Rica, approximately a 25-minute drive. Overnight stay in Poza Rica

Day 5- Poza Rica

In Poza Rica we will begin our day by riding the rapids. 4 hours approximately

We will then follow the Vanilla Murals route. 1hour approximately

The last activity before we end our tour will be a visit to Sopos Doña Carmen where we will taste her original sopos.
